## School Path

## Picking Children up, and dropping them to School

## Face coverings on School Transport

**This is the current advice from the Ministry of Education**

Students of all ages are encouraged to wear a face covering on all school transport services under ALL alert levels.

Providing face coverings is the responsibility of individuals and caregivers. Any student who is unwell should not travel on a school or public bus.

### Students aged 12 and over

Face coverings **MUST** be worn by students aged 12 and over while on school transport under ALL alert levels.

### Students under 12

Students aged under 12 are not required to wear face coverings on school transport, but they are encouraged to.
